A NOTE ON SCHEDULES

The last day to request a change to your schedule for next year is **June 15th**. To do so, you must complete [this form](#), which also includes the waiver (should you be choosing to waive a teacher recommendation). You must be logged into your browser with your GV Google account in order to access the form. After June 15th, you will no longer be able to access the form.

The counseling office will not be processing any schedule change requests over the summer.

After you receive your schedule, there will be a window of time from **August 15th-August 21st** for you to try to make a schedule change. Schedule changes will be available via email or appointment. Any schedule change requests are subject to availability.



Other Frequently Asked Questions

Working Permits

- Click on [this link](#) and complete the working permit application in full. It must also be signed by a parent.
- Send the completed application along with a copy of proper documentation to Mrs. Van Horn (vanhorn@garnetvalley.org) or Mrs. Picciotti (piccioc@garnetvalley.org) via email for verification.
- Once the application and identification have been received, you will receive an email for a quick video conference to verify all information. Parents are welcomed to join the video conference, too. *Please know that the video session will be recorded.
- Once all information has been verified, the working permit will be mailed. The applicant will need to sign the permit when it is received. Please keep the original working permit and give out copies as needed.
